### Code of Conduct 2016-2017

The Youth League is a non-competitive league established to allow girls from Years 7, 8 and 9 to play rotational and traditional netball, learn new positions and acquire new skills in umpiring, timekeeping and scoring.

#### **Players should:**

- Make their club a fun place to be.
- Play fairly and be trustworthy and show team spirit.
- Show appropriate loyalty and be gracious in defeat.
- Respect officials and accept decisions.
- Respect opponents, other youth members/leaders.
- Not get involved in inappropriate peer pressure and push others into something they do not want to do.
- Wear suitable kit/trainers, hair tied back, short nails and no jewellery.
- Report any concerns to your Youth Leader or Safeguarding Officer.
- Be responsible for their behaviour when using the internet and to not post material regarding Jersey Netball or any individual club or member that could be considered threatening, offensive, upsetting, bullying or illegal.

#### **Parents / Spectators should:**

- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in their chosen activity.
- Do not place your child under pressure or push them into activities they do not want to do.
- Deliver and collect your child punctually.
- Detail any relevant medical concerns or conditions pertaining to their child on the registration/consent form. Any changes in the state of the child's health should be reported to the coach/school/event staff prior to the activity.
- Encourage your child to play by the rules, and teach them that they can only do their best.
- Be responsible for their behaviour when using the internet and to not post material regarding Jersey Netball or any individual club or player that could be considered threatening, offensive, upsetting, bullying or illegal.
